**PUBLIC NOTICE REGARDING REAPPOINTMENT
OF MAGISTRATE JUDGE GEORGE W. FOLEY, JR.**

The current term of office of United States Magistrate Judge George W. Foley, Jr., will expire on August 3, 2013. The United States District Court is required by law to establish a panel of citizens to consider the reappointment of the magistrate judge to a new eight-year term.

The duties of a magistrate judge in this court include the following: (1) conduct preliminary proceedings in criminal cases; (2) trial and disposition of misdemeanor cases; (3) conduct various pretrial matters and evidentiary proceedings on delegation from the judges of the district court; and (4) trial and disposition of civil cases upon consent of the litigants.

Written comments from members of the bar and the public are invited as to whether Magistrate Judge George W. Foley, Jr. should be recommended by the panel for reappointment by the Court. Please send comments to:
