
GENERAL ORDER NO. 2007- 04

Pending formal amendment of the Local Rules of Practice of this Court,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, absent good cause shown, all motions or stipulations for the continuance of a criminal trial or sentencing hearing shall be filed at least ten (10) days before the scheduled trial or hearing. Each request for a continuance shall be accompanied by a statement of the number of prior continuances, if any, a detailed description of the reason(s) the request is being made, and if it is a second or successive request, it shall contain a detailed description of what has occurred since the last continuance was granted. Any response to a motion to continue shall be filed within three (3) calendar days from the date of service of the motion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this General Order shall become effective as of January 2, 2008.
