To distribute cases among the judges of this court pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. § 137, the Clerk of the Court will randomly assign civil and criminal cases to both the district and magistrate judges at the direction of and with the approval of the Court. The method and percentage of caseload assigned to each judicial officer will be determined by the District Judges. In the event that a judicial officer must recuse themselves for cause, the Clerk of Court will assign the case to a judge through this random selection process. The Clerk of Court shall monitor assignments and shall report the status of this process to the Chief Judge on a regular basis.
