SPECIAL ORDER NO. 14

Persons charged with violation in this District within the territorial jurisdiction of a United States Magistrate, of any offense listed below, based upon the authority of 62 Stat. 281, as amended (40 U.S.C. 318; 63 Stat. 377, as amended; 38 FR 23838 and 38 FR 27945); 43 CFR 421, effective as of February 7, 1974. (See Federal Register, Vol. 39, No. 27) presently applicable or as hereafter amended, may, unless "Mandatory Appearance" is indicated for the particular offense, or the officer issuing the citation (at his discretion in aggravated cases) requires a personal appearance, post collateral in the amount indicated for the offense, waive appearance before a Magistrate, and consent to forfeiture of the collateral, which forfeiture shall be equivalent to a conviction.

Nothing contained in the Order shall prohibit a law enforcement officer from arresting a person for the commission of any offense, including, if the circumstances warrant, those offenses for which collateral may be posted for forfeiture, and taking such arrested person or persons before the United State Magistrate.

If a person charged with an offense fails to post and forfeit collateral (as above provided and authorized), any punishment, including fine, imprisonment, or probation, may be imposed within the limits provided in law upon conviction by plea or after trial.

This Special Order supersedes all previous orders relative to this matter.
