SPECIAL ORDER NO. 16

O R D E R

In accordance with the authority conferred by 28 U.S.C., Section 631, pursuant to which provisions prior joint consent and approval was given therefor by the United States District Judges for both Districts of Arizona and Nevada, and upon the further action taken and authority granted by the Judicial Conference of the United States at its session on April 6th and 7th, 1972,

IT IS ORDERED that the duly appointed and acting full-time United States Magistrate officially stationed at Las Vegas, Nevada, shall be, and he hereby is appointed, authorized and empowered to exercise jurisdiction over the entire Lake Mead National Recreation Area, including that portion lying within the District of Arizona; however, subject to and conditioned upon the entry of a corresponding order to the same effect to be made by the United States District Court for the District of Arizona.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the exercise of jurisdiction, and authority and powers over the Lake Mead National Recreation Area, including that portion lying with the District of Arizona, hereinabove provided, shall be and become immediately effective only upon entry of a corresponding and concurring order to the same effect by the United States District Court for the District of Arizona, if any, and the receipt and filing of a certified copy thereof as of record by the Clerk of this Court, and also


only on and after a full-time magistrate shall be duly so appointed, and be so acting, pursuant to appropriate order therefor made and entered by this Court.

The Clerk shall forward certified copies of this order to (1) the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Arizona; (2) the Honorable Walter E. Craig, Chief Judge of the United States District Court for the District of Arizona; (3) the Honorable Joseph L. Ward, United States Magistrate, Las Vegas, Nevada; (4) the Honorable Lee E. Bruno, United States Magistrate, Kingman, Arizona; (5) the Honorable Richard C. Gormley, United States Magistrate, Phoenix, Arizona; and (6) the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts.

This Special Order supersedes all previous orders relative to this matter.
