AS AMENDED

The United States Marshal's Service having made representations to the Court that their agency is under such severe budgetary restraints that it is no longer possible for the Marshal's Service to make efficient service of civil process, and it appearing to the Court that a large number of United States District Courts have entered orders relieving the Marshal in their districts from responsibility of service of civil process, and the Court being fully advised in the premises, NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS'

ORDERED that pursuant to the authority contained in Rule 4(c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the United States Marshal for the District of Nevada will not serve civil process except in the following circumstances:

- (1) Service of process upon or on behalf of the United States of America;
- (2) Service of process pursuant to a specific order of a judge or magistrate of this Court;
- (3) Service of process in aid of attachment or execution.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon the filing of the complaint the clerk shall forthwith issue a summons and deliver it for service to the



plaintiff or his attorney who shall have the sole responsibility for making arrangements for service;


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that service of civil process in all cases except those enumerated above shall be by appointment of a special process server. The Clerk shall make available to counsel, upon request, the appropriate form of motion and order for appointment of a special process server;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Special Order No. 32 entered on the 18th day of June, 1981, is hereby superceded and canceled.
