15 This order governs the random assignment of newly filed cases. The formulas implemented
16 by this order are intended to result in the Honorable Edward C. Reed, Jr., and the Honorable Lloyd
17 D. George, Senior United States District Judges, receiving a caseload equivalent to fifty percent of
18 the average caseload of the active judges for this District.

19 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

20 1. The Clerk of Court establish at Las Vegas and Reno a random draw system for civil and
21 criminal cases, as set forth in the schedules indicated in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, for all new filings
22 effective March 1, 1999.

23 2. Case assignments in death penalty cases filed on or after March 1, 1999, will be divided
24 equally among all of the active judges in the District of Nevada, with Senior Judges Reed and George
25 receiving an equivalent of only fifty percent of the average active judges' caseload, notwithstanding the
26 unofficial division in which such cases may arise. The Clerk of Court will assign such cases by random
27 draw. In the event a death penalty case is filed which requires immediate action and the judge to whom
28 the case is assigned is unavailable due to illness, absence from the district or other reason, the Clerk shall

1 submit the action for consideration to the judge next drawn at random who is available.


