120-6,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the procedures set forth below shall
be followed regarding admission of government attorneys who are
residents of this District and not otherwise eligible for admission
under Local Rule 120-2 to practice before this Court.

Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, any attorney, a member
in good standing of the highest court of any State, Commonwealth or
territory or of the District of Columbia, who is employed by the
United States as an attorney and, while being so employed, has
occasion to appear in this Court on behalf of the United States,
shall, upon motion of the United States Attorney or the Federal
Public Defender for the District of Nevada or one of the assistants,
and upon taking the oath prescribed by Local Rule 120-4 (a), be
permitted to practice before this Court during the period of such
employment.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such permission to practice before
2 this Court is a limited one and no certificate shall be issued by the
3 clerk, nor admission fee required.
