SPECIAL ORDER NO. 80

Judge Bruce R. Thompson, appointed by President John F. Kennedy, took his oath of office as a Judge of the United States District Court for the District of Nevada on August 30, 1963, and served as Judge thereof until his death on February 10, 1992. Because of his distinguished career upon this bench and because of the high esteem in which he was held by this Court, the bar and the public, the Court desires to place upon its record an appropriate memorial to him.

The Court now designates Friday, May 29, 1992 at three o'clock p.m., in Reno, Nevada, as the date for the presentation of said memorial.


