

In Re: Development and implementation of a Federal Court Veterans Diversion Program for adjudication of Central Violations Bureau (CVB) citations at the Veterans Administration Medical (VAM) facility, Reno, Nevada

The U.S. District Court for the Unofficial Northern Division of the District of Nevada and the Veterans Administration Medical (VAM) Reno have identified the need for more specific, individualized options for the resolution of mental health/substance abuse CVB citations issued at the northern Nevada Veterans Administration Medical facility. Working together, a pilot program has been created to address this need.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED the program known as Federal Court Veterans Diversion Program shall proceed in the Unofficial Northern Division for the District of Nevada for a period of one year after which it will be further evaluated. The program will be managed by the U.S. Magistrate Judges of the Unofficial Northern Division of the U.S. District Court of the District of Nevada.
