

Authorizing the United States Marshal's Service and the Las Vegas Field Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation to Accept Prescribed Bail and to Conditionally Release Certain Violators and Offenders and to Set a Forfeiture of Collateral In Lieu of Personal Appearance for Certain Violations of United States Code and the Code of Federal Regulations in the State and Federal District of Nevada.



GENERAL ORDER 2019-01

ORDER

This matter having come before the Court on the application by the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Nevada for an Order authorizing the United States Marshals Service (USMS) for the District of Nevada and the Las Vegas Field Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) to issue citations for violations of certain Code of Federal Regulations and United States Code, and for good cause appearing therefore:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the USMS and the Las Vegas Field Office of the FBI are now authorized to issue citations for violations the specifically enumerated offenses set forth in charts attached to this Order as Exhibits A and B.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT the proposed bail schedule and forfeiture of collateral schedule for the enumerated offenses are approved by the Court as set forth in Exhibits A and B.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the USMS is authorized to apply to the Central Violations Bureau (CVB) for the appropriate location code for the United States Magistrate

1 Judge's court in Las Vegas, Nevada, with respect to all violation notices as set forth in Exhibit
2 A relating to violations of certain Federal regulations and law on Federal property located in
3 the unofficial Southern Division of the District of Nevada (Clark, Esmeralda, Lincoln, and
4 Nye counties) and a location code for the United States Magistrate Judge's court in Reno,
5 Nevada, with respect to all violation notices as set forth in Exhibit A relating to violations of
6 certain Federal regulations and law on Federal property in the unofficial Northern Division of
7 the District of Nevada (Carson City, Churchill, Douglas, Elko, Eureka, Humboldt, Lander,
8 Lyon, Mineral, Pershing, Storey, Washoe, and White Pine counties).

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Las Vegas Field Office of the FBI is authorized
10 to apply to the Central Violations Bureau (CVB) for the appropriate location code for the
11 United States Magistrate Judge's court in Las Vegas, Nevada, with respect to violations the
12 enumerated offenses as set forth in Exhibit B that occur on or at airport facilities that are
13 subject to oversight by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) in Clark County and Nye
14 County, Nevada, which are both located in the unofficial Southern Division of the District of
15 Nevada.


