IN RE: LIMITED PHYSICAL ACCESS TO THE CLERK'S OFFICE AND FURTHER MODIFICATIONS OF COURT OPERATIONS UNDER THE EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES CREATED BY COVID-19 AND RELATED CORONAVIRUS

AMENDED TEMPORARY GENERAL ORDER 2020-04

In response to the recent outbreak of the coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19") in the District of Nevada, the Court has issued a series of general orders changing how the Court operates to do its part in containing the spread of COVID-19. See Temporary General Orders 2020-02, 2020-03, 2020-04, 2020-05.¹ In General Order 2020-04, the Court closed the Clerk's Office to the public and expressed the need to eliminate inperson court appearances. That Order also provides that the Court will vacate or amend it on or before April 30, 2020. The Court hereby amends General Order 2020-04 as follows:

A. Clerk's Office

1) The intake window in the Clerk's Office will continue to be closed to the public to ensure effective social distancing for the protection of employees and the public. This limited physical access does not affect any filings. Attorneys and pro se parties may continue to file documents with the Court. All deadlines remain in full effect unless otherwise ordered by the presiding judge.

- 2) Filings will be processed via the electronic filing system (CM/ECF) and via U.S. mail, email, or delivery. Paper documents delivered to the courthouses must be deposited in drop boxes located in the lobbies of the Lloyd D. George Federal Courthouse in Las Vegas located at 333 Las Vegas Blvd. South, Las Vegas NV 89101, and the Bruce R. Thompson Federal Courthouse located at 400 S. Virginia Street, Reno NV 89501. Drop-box access will be available between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on business days. Effective May 18, 2020, filings sent by mail will be deemed filed on the date received by the Clerk's Office.
- 3) Documents that cannot be filed electronically via CM/ECF may also be submitted email. filings by Las Vegas may be emailed to Iv public docketing@nvd.uscourts.gov. Reno filings may be emailed to reno public docketing@nvd.uscourts.gov. In addition, pro se parties may consent to receive electronic notices of filing and/or delivery of documents by email. Additional information about filing and receiving notices/delivery of the Court's website documents by email can be found on https://www.nvd.uscourts.gov/self-help/.
- 4) Manual filings may be served on opposing parties without securing a filestamped copy.
- 5) LR IC 2-2(g)'s requirement to submit to chambers paper copies of electronic filings that exceed 50 pages is suspended while access to the Clerk's Office remains limited. However, each presiding judge may direct a party to submit courtesy copies directly to chambers.
- 6) Payments made by check or money order will be accepted by mail or in the courthouse drop boxes during the hours noted above. Cash payments will not be accepted during this period of exigent circumstances.

7) Staff in the Clerk's Office will be available by telephone and email, mail will be received, and new filings will be processed. The contact phone number for the Clerk's Office in Las Vegas is (702) 464-5402; the Clerk's Office in Reno can be reached at (775) 686-5800. The Help Desk can also be reached at helpdesk_vegas@nvd.uscourts.gov.

B. Court Hearings

The Court plans to incrementally resume in-person court appearances as appropriate based on recommended health guidelines. To ensure maximum distancing, the presiding judge may limit the number of individuals who may physically be in the courtroom for an in-person court hearing and allow participation by telephone. Moreover, members of the public may call in to listen to a scheduled hearing on the phone line provided for each hearing. This Order does not impact the Court's consideration of motions that can be resolved without an in-court appearance.

This Order is effective until further notice.
