SECOND AMENDED TEMPORARY **GENERAL ORDER 2020-03**

In response to the outbreak of the coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19") in the District of Nevada, the Court has issued a series of general orders changing how the Court operates to do its part in containing the spread of COVID-19. See General Orders 2020-02, 2020-03, 2020-04, 2020-05, 2020-08, 2020-09, 2020-10 (the "COVID-19") General Orders"). In Amended General Order 2020-03, the Court continued all jury trials indefinitelly. Since then, the Court has begun incrementally resuming limited inperson hearings, though the Court recognizes that emergency conditions that led the Court to authorize the use of video and telephone conferencing under the "Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act" ("CARES Act") continue to exist. The Court now amends Temporary General Order 2020-03 to allow jury trials to proceed in accordance with the Court's internal plan for resuming jury trials.
