ORDER FURTHER EXTENDING
AMENDED
TEMPORARY GENERAL ORDER
2020-05

On March 30, 2020, I issued Temporary General Order 2020-05 to authorize the use of video and telephone conferencing under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES Act"). On March 25, 2022, I issued a new version of that order—Amended Temporary General Order 2020-05 (the "Amended Order")—which was effective for 90 days, or until June 23, 2022. I then twice extended the Amended Order for another 90 days. I have again reviewed the emergency conditions that led to the issuance of the Amended Order and find that such emergency conditions continue to exist in the District of Nevada. Accordingly, as Chief Judge, and under Section 15002(b)(1) of the CARES Act, I hereby extend the Amended Order for another 90 days, until March 20, 2023, unless that Order is terminated earlier.
