IN RE: ENDING MOST MODIFICATIONS OF COURT OPERATIONS IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19 AND THE RELATED CORONAVIRUS

GENERAL ORDER 2023-04

In response to the outbreak of the coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19"), the Court issued a series of general orders addressing the Court's efforts to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 in the District of Nevada. On May 11, 2023, the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency ("PHE") Declaration ended. See, e.g., Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, End of the Federal COVID-19 Public Health Emergency (PHE) (May 5, 2023), https://perma.cc/8MKF-V8KE. And as the Court has now resumed normal operations, the Court finds it appropriate to vacate additional general orders enacted in response to COVID-19, specifically: Temporary General Order 2020-02 (including its amended versions addressing face coverings). In addition, Third Amended GO 2020-04 is vacated, except that the Court continues to indefinitely extend the temporary suspension of LR IC 2-2(g); parties need not provide courtesy copies of electronically filed documents that exceed 50 pages in length unless the presiding judge orders otherwise or until such time as the local rule is amended.

Further, the Court continues the modification of LR IC 2-1 in that documents that cannot be filed electronically via the electronic case management system (CM/ECF) may submitted email. emailed be by Las Vegas filings be may to Iv public docketing@nvd.uscourts.gov. Reno filings emailed mav be to reno public docketing@nvd.uscourts.gov. In addition, pro se parties may consent to receive electronic notices of filing an/or delivery of documents by email.
