GENERAL ORDER 2023-10

The United States District Court for the District of Nevada has a constitutional duty to continue to hear and resolve cases, even during a period of partial government shutdown. To perform this constitutional duty, judges rely on their personal staff, as well as the officers and employees of the Court, to perform functions necessary and essential to the continued resolution of cases. Therefore, and consistent with national directives, if appropriations for the current fiscal year are not continued or funded before the expiration of the Continuing Appropriations Act, all staff, officers, and employees of the United States District Court for the District of Nevada are ordered to report to work during their normally scheduled hours until further notice. The Court will continue to evaluate the fiscal situation and will adjust this directive as required.
