ORDER

The purpose of this order is to appoint Maximiliano D. Couvillier III as a new United States Magistrate Judge within the District of Nevada. The Court has fully complied with the provisions of Title 28, United States Code, Sections 631-639, inclusive, as amended, and the Regulations of the Judicial Conference of the United States Establishing Standards and Procedures for the Appointment of United States Magistrate Judges, as amended.

In accordance with the authority conferred by Title 28, United States Code, Section 631, *et seq.*, and the further authority granted and action taken by the Judicial Conference of the United States, and by unanimous vote of the active judges of this Court, it is therefore ordered that Maximiliano D. Couvillier III be, and hereby is, appointed as a full-time United States Magistrate Judge, with his official duty station at Las Vegas, Nevada, at the salary fixed by the Judicial Conference of the United States, effective January 8, 2024, first however, having taken the oath or affirmation prescribed by Title 28, United States Code, Sections 453 and 631(g).


