## For name changes that occurred in 2020 to 2023:

You may come in person to the court and request copies. You must provide the date of your Naturalization ceremony. The time of your ceremony is helpful as multiple ceremonies are held on each date. If you only have an approximate month and year, you may be asked to fill out the form and the clerk will contact you after a search of court records.

## For name changes that occurred between the years 2012 and 2019:

These records are stored at the Federal Record Center (FRC) in Riverside, California. For electronic retrievals from FRC, the fee is \$20.90 plus copying fees. Complete the request form and submit it to the court. You will be contacted by the clerk with the total amount due for services.

# For name changes that occurred in 2011 or older years:

The clerk's office does not have access to these records. These records are at the National Archives.
